Brief Description of the Event: National Service Scheme Unit of Saraswati Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Dhanap – Gandhinagar had organized Blood Donation Camp in association with “AHMEDABAD RED CORSS BLOOD PROGRAMME” and Alumni Association of Saraswati Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences on 12.02.2020 at Saraswati Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Gandhinagar, and Gujarat as part of various activities of the NSS unit.

Total 60 units of blood were donated by the volunteers, alumni students, students and staff of institute. Among 60 donors, 38 donors had donated the blood first time.
