Outcomes of Event:

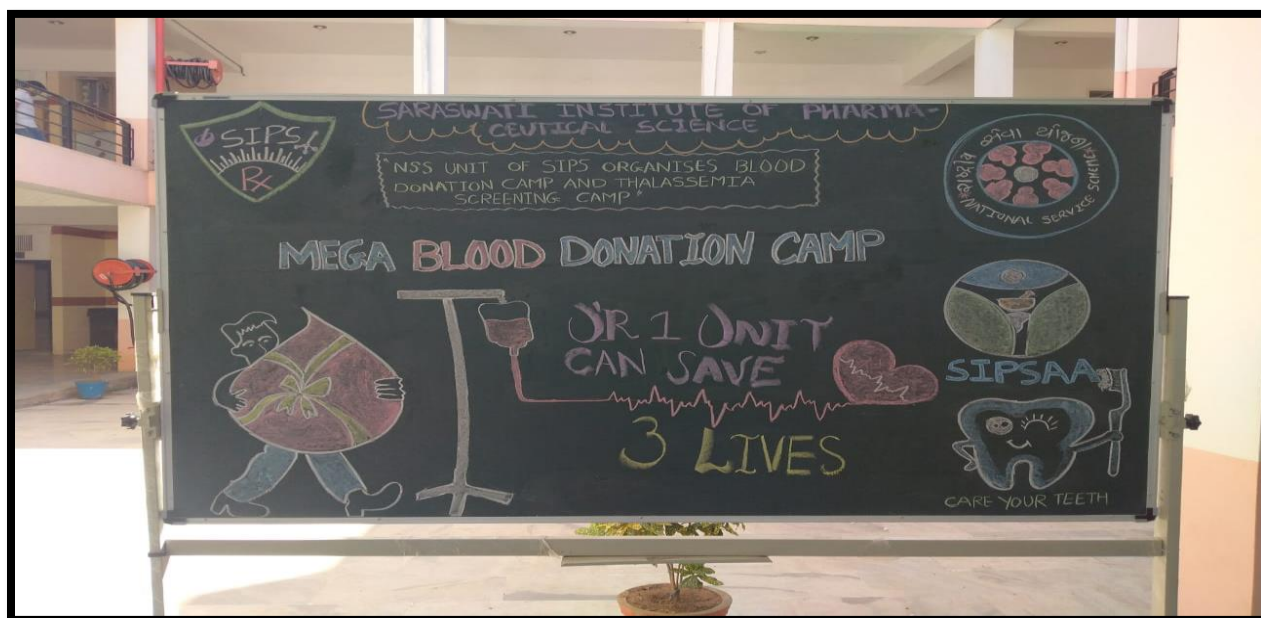
The following outcomes of National Service Scheme (NSS) may achieve through the camp as follows:
