happiness, leaving everyone with unforgettable memories, smiles, and a deep sense of belonging.

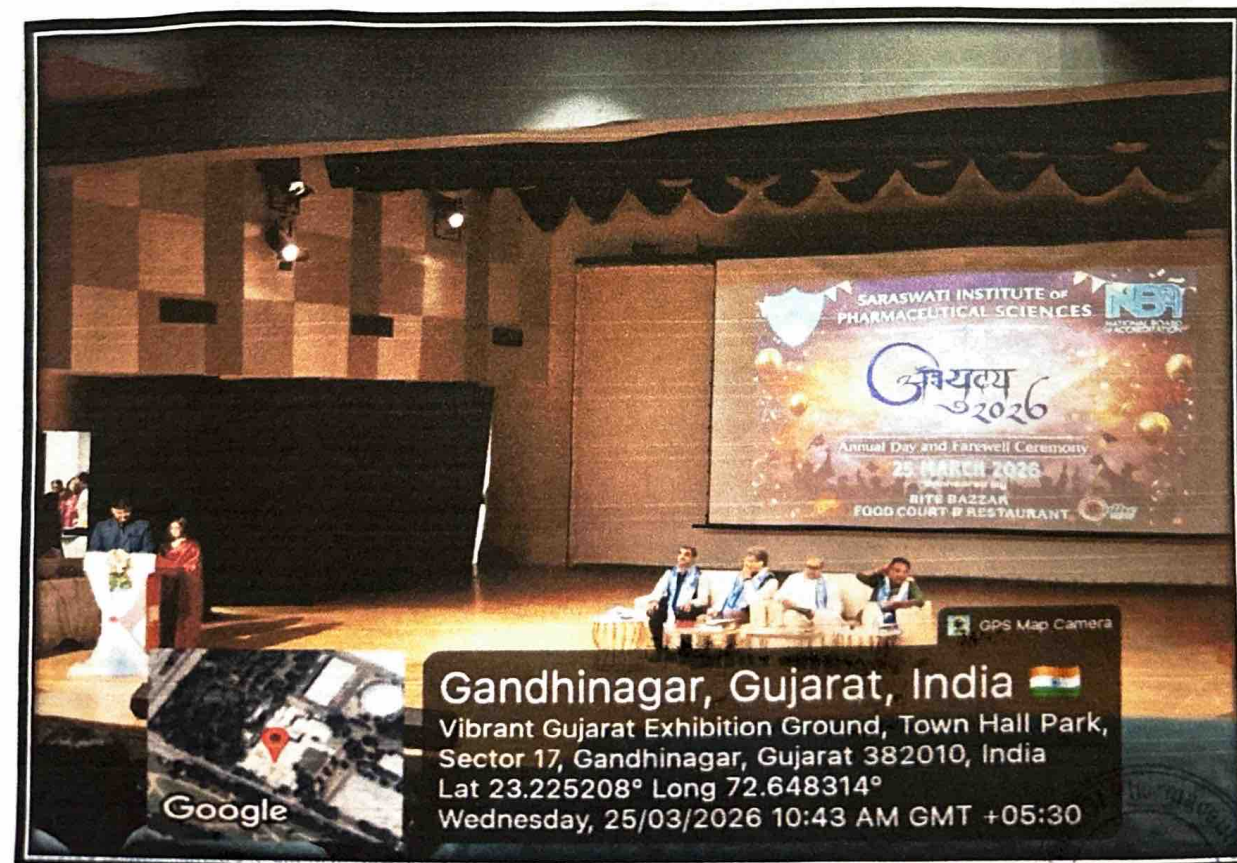

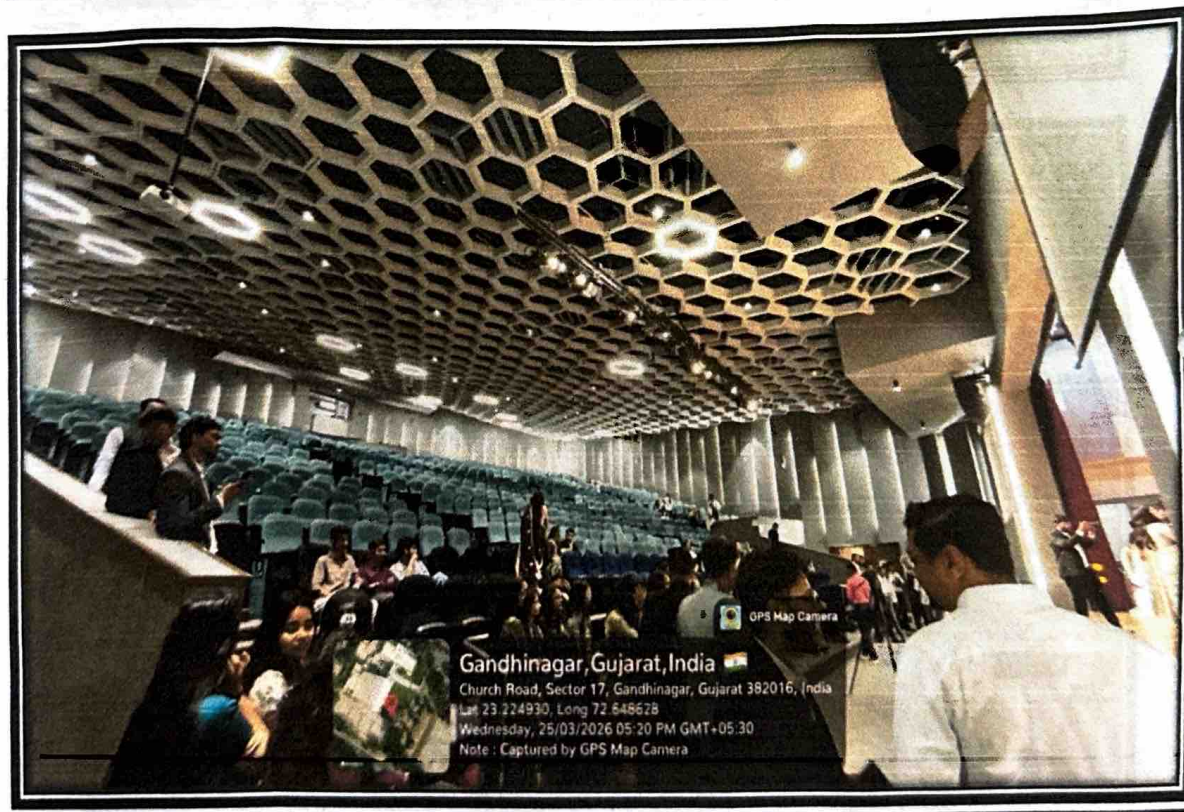
