Guest of Honor Address – Shri Shwetel Sutaria

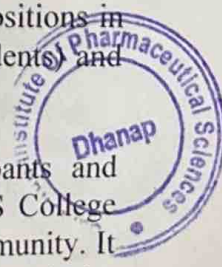

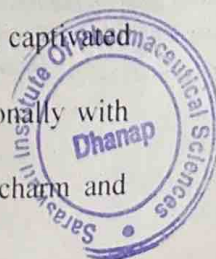
Program Highlights
