Thalassemia Minor Screening and Blood Donation Camp had organized by NSS Unit of Institute, Saraswati Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences Alumni Association (SIPSAA) and Red Cross Society, Ahmedabad on 03/02/2022 at institute. The team of Indian red cross society, Gujarat State Branch had done counseling of the students for Thalassemia screening and prevention. The information was very effective and useful for the prevention of Thalassemia. Blood sample of 181 students was collected for the Thalassemia screening.

In blood donation, A total of 86 unit of blood were donated by the faculty, alumni, students and volunteers of NSS of the institute. Among these 86 units 34 student gave blood for the first time and out of them 09 girl student donate blood. 35 students were rejected by the doctor for not having a require level of hemoglobin or weight but they have noble motive to donate blood in future. Red Cross Society provided food packets and certificates to blood donors. This kind of activity inculcate social responsibilities in the students.

Report:

Keeping in mind the current corona pandemic situation, recently Saraswati Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences (SIPS), Dhanap encouraged students to actively participate in covid duty, initiated by Gujarat State Pharmacy Council (GSPC) and Pharmavision Aayam, ABPV and Federation of Gujarat state chemist and druggist association.

After Ahmedabad saw one of the worst outbreaks, the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (A.M.C) launched a series of initiatives time to time. One of which is "Sanjeevni Rath". It has been developed to check up on covid patients who are self-isolating in their homes. The city has been divided into seven zones/jurisdictions and each zone has been demarcated into ten-twelve Urban health centers, L.G. hospital and SVP hospital. Each team has been allotted a vehicle along with driver, which is used for this helpline to reach the patients at their doorsteps. Total 44 students (27 Pharm.D students and 17 B.Pharm students) of SIPS actively participated and were sent to L.G Medical College and hospital, Maninagar for this noble cause. Students were divided into 2 teams, Team 1 consisted of 25 students who gave duty from 18/01/2022 to 26/01/2022 (9 days) and Team 2 consisted of 21 students who gave duty from 27/01/2022 to 01/02/2022 (6 days). The timings for the duty were from 8:00 AM to 1:30 PM. Students were given training for 3 days under assigned teams consisting of doctors, medical officers and MBBS interns. Later on they had been assigned individual team to carry out their duties in their respective zones and UHC's. The students along with the doctor or a paramedic visit the quarantined patient's house every alternate day and check the patient for fever, appetite, breathlessness, fatigue and headache among other symptoms. Students also check the pulse rate, temperature, blood pressure, SPO2 levels of the patients and provide them with medicines if required as per their symptoms. Each of our students used to visit minimum of 12 patients daily. On an average, students from our college interacted with over 4212 patients in a period of 15 days. SIPS had given certificate of honor to all participating students for their contribution to the society.





When asked, the students responded that it was a very useful opportunity for them as they learned many things like patient counseling, how to deal with different kind of patients and gained a wide practical knowledge. Hence the institute gave a golden opportunity to students to gain on field experience in these hard times, the overall initiative was recommendable. Students also did a great job and were appreciated by many pharmacy officials for their work, precious involvement and contribution towards this service. Events like these helps the students to grow and achieve new milestones and should be conducted more often.

Report:

Pharmacy is professional course where practical knowledge is much more important along with theoretical knowledge. To percolate actual practical exposure, our institute had arranged Pathology Laboratory visit at GCC DNA Diagnostic Laboratory on 12th March 2022.

2nd and 3rd Year Pharm.D students had participated in the visit program, **Mr. Tushar Brahmbhatt** (General Manager, GCC DNA Diagnostic Laboratory, Naroda, Ahmedabad) had given very nice information about different techniques and testing carried out for COVID cases (manual and automated method), CBCC machine for diabetes testing, centrifuge CL-gooi for thyroid detection etc. in pathology laboratory. In this visit, the students had also visited molecular laboratory department and gathered extensive information about various RNA/DNA isolation techniques for gene testing.

The students were accompanied by faculty Mr. Sanket Vyas and Mr. Kaushik Kamani who guided and explained them about processing of microbiological testing in their syllabi at various Stages of visit to Pathology lab. The students were very happy and felt enriched after visiting a laboratory.

Pharmacy is professional course where practical knowledge is much more important along with theoretical knowledge. To percolate actual practical exposure, our institute had arranged industrial visit at Amneal Pharmaceuticals Co. India Pvt. Ltd. on 21st and 22nd April 2022.

Total 60 students had participated in the industrial visit program from 4th Sem B.Pharm. Bus Transport was arranged for students to visit the plant. During industrial visit, **Dr. Luv Sharma** (Manufacturing head, Amneal Pharmaceuticals, Matoda) and **Mr. Bhavik Patel** (Reasearch Associate, Accuprec Research Labs Pvt. Ltd., Changodar) had given detailed and descriptive information about



oral solid dosage forms OSD (tablets and capsules) Manufacturing, testing of various pharmaceuticals and biotechnological products. They oriented all major departments involved in making and packaging of OSD such as warehouse area, Granulation, blending, been feeding, compression, coating, packaging of Amneal Pharmaceuticals Co. India Pvt. Ltd. and physical testing, microbiological testing, preclinical testing, analytical testing, stability testing and IPQC of Accuprec Research Labs Pvt. Ltd. They correlated the study and actual working at industry and gap between the industry and Academia. During Visit, the students had received extensive information about designing of plant such as floors, walls, corridors, fire system, utility color coding system, barcode system etc. Students had learnt about recent GMP, FDA, WHO guideline and preparation of documents such as BMR and SOP.

in great detail. Doubt of delegates was cleared by speaker in Q and A session. The vote of thanks was delivered at the end of the session by Charmy D. Pandya.




