

Pharmacy is professional course where practical knowledge is much more important along with theoretical knowledge. To percolate actual practical exposure, our institute arranged industrial visit at Yash Medicare Pvt. Ltd. and Montage Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

Total 50 students participated in the industrial visit program from 4<sup>th</sup> Sem B.Pharm. Bus Transport was arranged for students to visit the plants. During industrial visit, representative of company at Yash Medicare Pvt. Ltd. was Mr. Hiren Mehta gave detailed and descriptive information about Semi solid Ointment manufacturing, labeling and packaging. They oriented all major departments involved in making and packaging of Semisolid dosage form such as raw material, warehouse area, Microbiology Lab, production, processing, AHU, quality control, HPLC, feeding, labeling and packaging.

At Montage Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Mr. Gunvant Patel gave detailed and descriptive information about parenteral formulations manufacturing, labeling and packaging. They oriented all major departments involved in making and packaging of parenteral such as raw material, warehouse area, temperature control unit, quality control, labeling and packaging.

They correlated the study and actual working at industry and gap between the industry and Academia.

During Visit, the students received extensive information about designing of plant such as floors, walls, corridors, fire system, utility color coding system, barcode system etc. Students learnt about recent GMP, FDA, WHO guidelines and preparation of documents such as BMR and SOP. The students were accompanied by faculty coordinators Mr. Sanket S. Vyas and Ms. Krutika A. Poshiya. They guided and explained them about processing of pharmaceutical

products at various stages during plant visit. The students were very happy and felt enriched after visiting a plant. Students learnt about recent GMP, FDA, WHO guidelines and preparation of documents.

Pharmacy is professional course where practical knowledge is much more important along with theoretical knowledge. To percolate actual practical exposure, our institute arranged 1 day AHA's BLS training program specifically the BLS components, where the students were trained to promptly recognize several emergencies like high-quality chest compressions (CPR), Emergency Cardiovascular Care (ECC) delivering appropriate ventilations using a barrier device and early use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) machine for adults, children, and infants. They were also given the detail knowledge about the importance of teams in multirescuer resuscitation and performance as an effective team member during multirescuer CPR and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction (choking) for adults and infants.




### 7. NSS INITIATIVES




### 7.5 INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY


