He shared a knowledge about Ayurvedic medicines and its importance. The session was informative & will be very helpful to the students to maintain their routine healthy lifestyle.



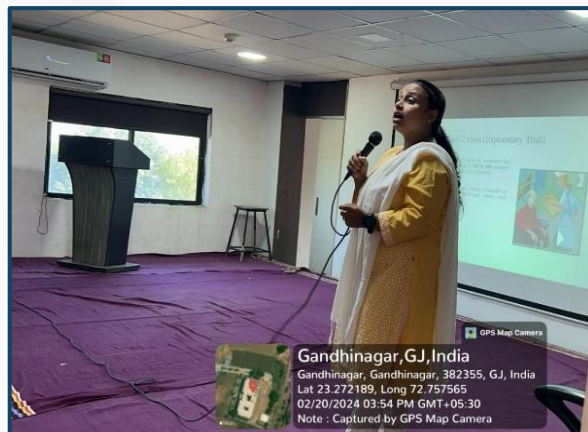

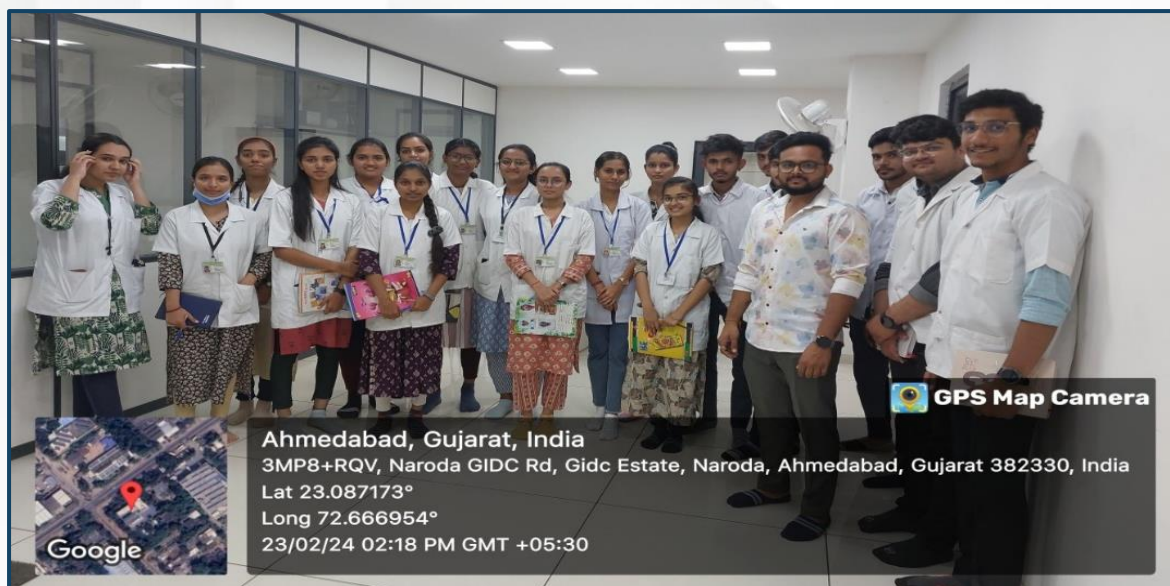

Pharmacy is professional course where practical knowledge is much more important along with theoretical knowledge. To percolate actual practical exposure, our institute had arranged Pathology Laboratory visit at NIA Charitable Hospital, Naroda on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2024.

Total 19 students had participated in the visit program from 2<sup>nd</sup> year Pharm D. During Pathology Laboratory visit, representative of laboratory had given very nice information about different techniques and testing carried out for blood analysis by cell counter, Immunoassay for vitamins, chloride and sodium, Urine sample analysis by Urine analyzer, Centrifugation of samples for different analysis by centrifuge and for storage of sample and reagents refrigerator. In this visit, the students had also learned about different rapid test kit used for detection malaria, typhoid, chicken Guinea and rapid urease kit. Representative of laboratory also explained function of Vacuum tube, Fluoride tube, Citrate tube and Plain tube. All instruments used for testing is from Siemens group of industry.

The students were accompanied by faculty Dr. Monvi Sachdev who guided and explained to them about processing of microbiological testing as per their syllabus at various Stages of visit to Pathology lab. The students were very happy and felt enriched after visiting a laboratory.

## 6.2 INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY CELEBRATION

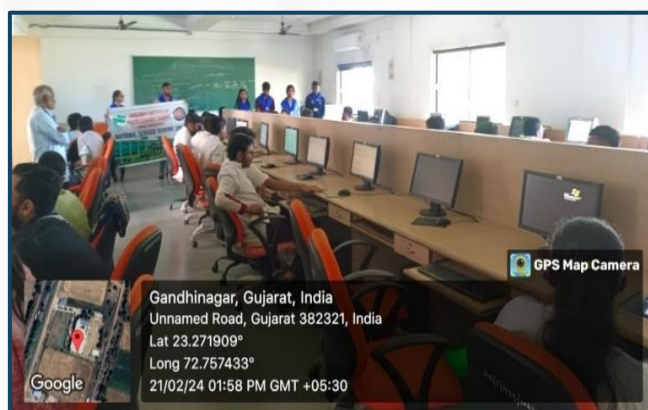
**Event Date:** 21<sup>st</sup> February 2024

**Event Date:** 16<sup>th</sup> March 2024

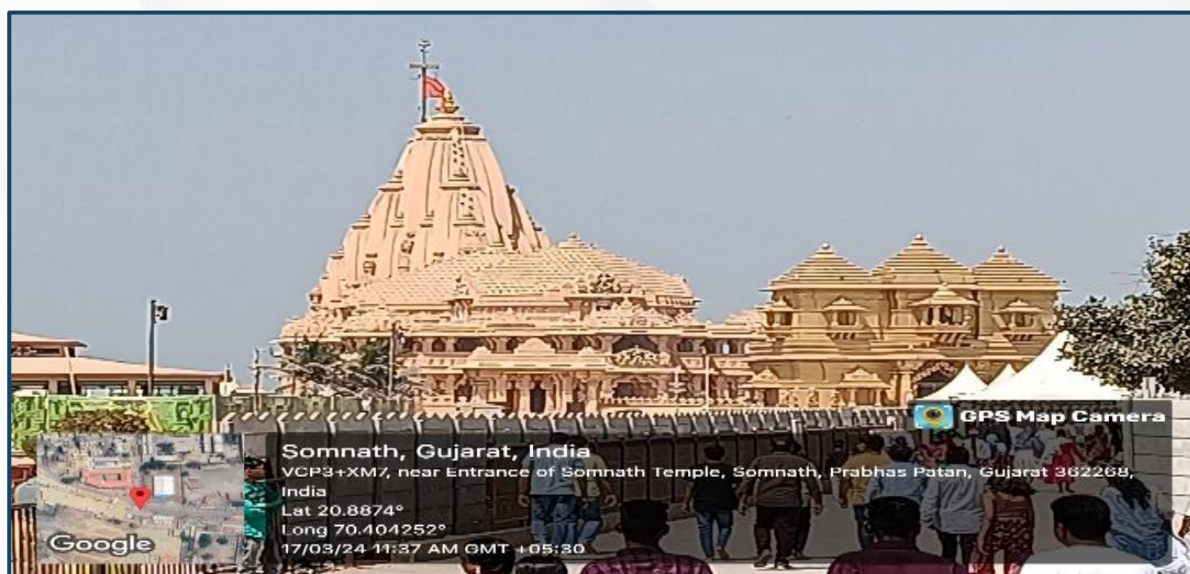
